The PACT act passed last month, and what a great win for Veterans with disabilities! This expands VA health care benefits for Veterans exposed to burn pits and other toxic substances. This adds more than 20 new presumptive conditions for burn pits and other toxic exposures, and presumptive exposure locations for Agent Orange and radiation. Any veteran that needs assistance with filing their VA benefits should reach out to our local VSO office. Their phone number is 303-914-5595. Do not hire someone to help you with your benefits, our VFW VSO office helps you at no charge! Ignore all the TV commercials wanting to "help" you – they want to "charge" you, sometimes upwards of 40% of your benefits.

I'd like to leave you with this...If you have not been down to your VFW Post in a while, perhaps it is time to come see us. We are working our butts off to make this the best VFW Post in the nation! It's the reason I show up every week! Stay well, and if you need anything at all, please don't hesitate to ask!

Honestly, I'm not sure of its name or even if has been named yet, but it's easy to find. If you just search "Veterans Affairs" in the Apple Store or Play Store, it will come right up. I'd encourage everyone to open it up and take a look.


